Brief Description:

The RIF4UA Project supports the integration of refugees in Romania and Hungary through social, educational, and skills development services. Implemented in Brasov and Budapest, the project aims to improve refugees' access to the labor market and foster social inclusion through RIF Centers (Resilience and Innovation Facilities). These centers will provide specialized support via multidisciplinary teams, educational programs for children, and vocational training opportunities for adults, thereby contributing to the socio-economic integration of refugees, including recognition of their qualifications in host countries.

- Improved access of Ukrainian refugees to social and educational/vocational services
- Enhanced employment-related skills among refugees in Hungary and Romania
- Increased access of refugees to the labor market
- Strengthened cooperation among local stakeholders to facilitate refugees' social and economic inclusion
